The rearing and testing facility is located on the premises of the Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station, which is a radiation-controlled area. Daily radiation control requires that we always wear dosimeters while working, check for contamination (radioactive substances adhered to clothing, etc.), and measure radiation levels to maintain radiation safety.
