The parasite we showed yesterday is a larva that hatches from an egg, reaches the gills of the flounder, and grows by sucking the blood of its host. After reaching maturity it lays eggs and the cycle begins again. In closed-circulation rearing, where the water is purified by microorganisms, it is difficult to use disinfectants, etc., thereby making it very difficult to eradicate the parasites once they have infested the water.
