- Today, April 25, the fuel debris sampled during the second fuel debris trial retrieval from Unit 2 was transported to the Japan Atomic Energy Agency (JAEA) Oarai Nuclear Engineering Institute at 2:38 PM.
- The transported fuel debris will be analyzed over a period of about one year to one and half years at analysis facilities such as the JAEA, etc., and the data acquired will be leveraged to deliberate when gradually enlarging the scope of fuel debris retrieval in the future.
- We will continue to prioritize safety as we move forward with this task.
