Status of Deliberations of Spent Fuel Receipt/Removal Plan for the Recyclable-Fuel Storage Company (RFS)

Today (July 7), an update on the status of deliberations of the mid/long-term receipt and removal plan for the Recyclable-Fuel Storage Center was given to Aomori Prefecture and Mutsu City.

It has taken time to deliberate this plan due to various fluctuating circumstances and uncertainties, and a final conclusion has yet to be reached, however it was conveyed that at this point in time we predict that a total of at least approximately 4,000~4,500 tons of storage capacity will be needed to accommodate Tokyo Electric Power Company Holdings Inc. and the Japan Atomic Power Company.

Deliberations will continue until we have compiled our final plan.
