Boring holes 2-14, 2-15 and 2-16 will be additionally drilled outside of the holes 2-10, 2-11 and 2-12 where all β was detected in order to understand the contaminated range.
The soil will be removed utilizing a steel pipe based on the result of the contaminated range.
Drilling of the boring holes 2-14, 2-15 and 2-16 will be performed from June 8, 2013.
