Completion of Roof Panel Removal from Unit 1 Building Cover at Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station

The removal of all roof panels from Unit 1 building cover was completed by removing the sixth (last) panel today.

No significant fluctuations in radioactive concentrations found by the dust monitors or from monitoring posts installed at the borders of the site.

After conducting investigations on the condition of rubble and dispersing anti-scattering agents, steel beams will be removed as they obstruct the installation of a water-spraying facility.

Timeline

- 7:07 a.m.: Start removing the sixth roof panel
- 7:40 a.m.: The roof panel removed
- 8:10 a.m.: Temporary placement of the panel (Completion of the removal)
