

Overview of Taiwan's Electric Power Industry

1 . Comparison between Taiwan and TEPCO

2 . Electric Power Demand

Taiwan's electricity demand is increasing, reflecting the economy's steady growth. The amount of electricity sold in 1999 totals 131.7 TWh, and reached 186.9 TWh in 2008(an average annual growth rate of approx4.7% between 1999 ~ 2008) .

3 . Electric Power Industry's Operating Entities:

The Taiwan Power Company delivers electricity through an integrated power generation, transmission, and distribution network. The government of Taiwan controls a majority share of this company, consequently placing its control under the Ministry of Economic Affairs.
