

### 1. TEPCO Kawasaki Recycle Center

This center started operations in November 2003 as the first Japanese facility to perform cleaning processes and recycling of small equipment including transformers installed on utility poles. Its name was changed to “Tokyo Power Technology Ltd. Kawasaki Recycle Center” on March 1, 2016.

- Location: 4-16, part of 4-13 and part of 4-17 Ogishima Kawasaki-ku Kawasaki city
- Area: Approximately 37, 800m<sup>2</sup>
- Business: Cleaning and recycling of small equipment such as transformers on utility poles with very small quantities of PCB
